Dear Parents and Carers,

Despite the cold temperatures and the dusting of snow this week, I have started to notice the early signs of spring on my drive into school in the mornings. The changing seasons and passing of time has led me to reflect on our journey so far since Ofsted last July. As a school we continue to work hard to look for ways to improve and develop the educational opportunities for your children. This term, we have been working on developing a consistent approach to teaching writing across the school and I have been impressed with the children's enthusiasm and progress they are making with the changes that have been made.

Curriculum leaders have also been reviewing their subject areas to ensure that our curriculum meets the needs of our children and encourages a love of learning. We recognise that activities that extend learning through new opportunities and experiences are really important; we are always looking for ways to enrich the curriculum.

World Book Day activities, 'wow' events and themed days are just a few of the ways we try to bring learning alive for our children. This week Year Five held a TTRockstars Day where they spent the day as *Rockstars* battling with their Times tables skills. The children were challenged to complete Times Tables based activities to support them with quicker recall of facts for their ongoing maths fluency. There was great excitement and lots of learning in both classes.



Following on from my earlier communication about good attendance, please read the blog: Why is school attendance so important and what are the risks of missing a day? Published by the Department for Education (DfE). The blog explains the risks to children of missing out on school and discusses the effects on children's wellbeing and wider development.

We have had a rising number of parents requesting to collect their children early at the end of the day. I would like to take this opportunity to remind parents that the school day finishes at 3:15pm and we ask that parents do not request to collect their children any earlier. We encourage parents/carers to make medical and dental appointments out of school hours where possible. Where this is not possible, children should be out of school for the minimum amount of time necessary.
