Dear Parents and Carers,

Reading is one of the most important skills we develop at school and a priority for our pupil. Thanks to the fundraising of FOWS we will be purchasing some new home reading



books linked to our Little Wandle Phonics programme for Key Stage One children. We are also very fortunate to have access to the Accelerated Reader programme, thanks to funding from FOWS.

Children move on to Accelerated Reader once they have gained a good grasp of reading using phonics and the reading schemes. Some children may start to use it in Year Two, but most make the transition from Year Three onwards. For more information please use this link https://winslow.bucks.sch.uk/about-us/library/

Each child is given a points target for the term, which they should be able to achieve if they are reading their Accelerated Reader book for at least 20 minutes each day. To encourage children to reach their targets we have added some new incentives:

- Each week a trophy will be awarded to the class in each year group, which has passed the most Accelerated Reader quizzes.
- At the end of each term, children who have reached their Accelerated Reader points target will be awarded a Sunflower Award Certificate. Names of these children will be entered in a draw to win a bag of goodies.

We have recently appointed 12 of our most enthusiastic readers in Year Six as Reading Ambassadors. Their job is to help promote reading for pleasure throughout the school. They also help in the school library at break-time. Their first task was to introduce themselves in our Reading Collective Worship this week. Although some of them were very nervous about this they did a fantastic job. Please look out for the next issue of our Reading Newsletter to find out what else they will be doing.

This morning Year Six led a whole school Remembrance Service with Rev. Mark and Derry from St Laurence Church and we all observed a minute of silence. Thank you to all the Year Six staff and pupils and all the parents/carers who attended the service.

We will be remembering our fallen in Winslow this Sunday and look forward to seeing as many of you as possible at the parade. Please arrive at the public hall car park by 10:30am wearing School Uniform. Our Head Boy and Head Girl will be laying a wreath at the Winslow War Memorial on behalf of the school.

Bullying affects millions of lives and can leave us feeling hopeless. We want to empower our children to challenge it, change it and reach out for support.




Flu Immunisations
