Dear Parents and Carers,

Start of Term reminders and information

Uniform

I would like to thank all our parents who make sure their children arrive at school in the correct school uniform. We are really proud of our school uniform and expect all children to wear it. Below is a reminder of the expectations for all pupils:

- Footwear with uniform should be black or brown practical school shoes. Trainers or fashion boots are not permitted as an alternative to school shoes.
- PE uniform is a plain white or navy blue t-shirt with blue or white plain shorts and a navy tracksuit for outdoor PE sessions - No football strips allowed.
- Distinctive hairstyles, including tramlines and coloured, dyed hair are not suitable for school.
- If ears are pierced, only one pair of studs may be worn for safety reasons. These should not be worn on PE days, but if they cannot be removed, they must be covered up with tape.
- Make up, including nail varnish, is not permitted in school.
- Long hair should be tied back. Headbands should be plain and simple, in school colours (navy, grey, white and black)

All clothing, including coats and shoes, should and clearly labelled with your child's name.

Attendance

At Winslow CE school we place great importance on good attendance and punctuality. We know that a child's attendance has a direct impact on their learning. Those children who are regularly absent from school and regularly late do not achieve their potential and do fall behind in class.

Please support the school in this by ensuring that your child attends school regularly and arrives ready to learn and on time between 8.40am and 8:50am. Registration is at 8:55am and children arriving after this time should enter the school through the main reception.

Allergies

We have a number of children with severe nut allergies in the school and we are asking for your co-operation in helping us to reduce the risk which these children face every day in school.

The risks are from contact with other children who have eaten allergens and not just from the foods themselves. These allergies are potentially life threatening.

Please help us by trying to avoid nuts in your child's packed lunch. For example: peanut butter sandwiches, chocolate spread sandwiches which contain nuts (e.g. nutella) and snack bars which nuts. Thank you for your support with this.



Parking

Just a quick reminder about parking around our school. Can we ask that as parents and carers you remain courteous to our residents when dropping off and collecting your child from school. Please do not block paths or driveways.

Many of our children live within walking distance and we actively promote this as a safer and healthier lifestyle choice for all.

Parents' Evenings

We are delighted to be welcoming you back into school for face-to-face meetings with your child's class teacher this term. These meetings will take place on Monday 10th October and Wednesday 12th October and will provide an opportunity for you to discuss how your child/children have settled and ways you can support their progress at home.
