# Start of term reminders and information

#### Uniform

I would like to thank all our parents who make sure their children arrive at school in the correct school uniform. We are really proud of our school uniform and expect all children to wear it. Below is a reminder of the expectations for all pupils:

- Footwear with uniform should be black or brown practical school shoes. Trainers or fashion boots are not permitted as an alternative to school shoes.
- PE uniform is a plain white or navy blue t-shirt with blue or white plain shorts and a navy tracksuit for outdoor outdoor PE sessions - no football strips allowed.
- Distinctive hairstyles, including tramlines and coloured, dyed hair are not suitable for school.
- If ears are pierced, only one pair of studs may be worn for safety reasons. These should not be worn on PE days, but if they cannot be removed, they must be covered up with tape.
- Make up, including nail varnish, is not permitted in school.
- Long hair should be tied back. Headbands should be plain and simple, in school colours (navy, grey, white and black)

All clothing, including coats and shoes, should and clearly labelled with your child's name.

#### **Attendance**



At Winslow CE school we place great importance on good attendance and punctuality. We know that a child's attendance has a direct impact on their learning. Those children who are regularly absent from school and regularly late do not achieve their potential and do fall behind in class.

Please support the school in this by ensuring that your child attends school regularly and arrives ready to learn and on time between 8.40am and 8:50am. Registration is at 8:55am

and children arriving after this time should enter the school through the main reception.

We are introducing a new incentive system to encourage regular school attendance and look forward to sharing information about this with you very soon.

# **Allergies**

We have a number of children, and some staff, with severe nut allergies in the school and we are asking for your co-operation in helping us to reduce the risk which they face every day in school.

The risks are from contact with others who have eaten allergens and not just from the foods themselves. These allergies are potentially life threatening.

Please help us by trying to avoid nuts in your child's packed lunch. For example: peanut butter sandwiches, chocolate spread sandwiches which contain nuts (e.g. nutella) and snack bars with nuts. Thank you for your support with this.

## **Parking**

Just a quick reminder about parking around our school. Can we ask that as parents and carers you remain courteous to our residents when dropping off and collecting your child from school. Please do not block paths or driveways.

If you have no other choice but to drive to school, park further away and walk the remainder of the way to ensure that the roads remain a safe place for our school community. Please can I remind everyone of the following:

- Cars should not park anywhere on the school grounds unless you have a specific agreement with the school and this is for good reason
- The staff car park should not be used by parents at any time
- Parking behind the bungalows is for residents only and should not be used for parking by parents dropping off or collecting
- Dropping off children in the morning using the turning circle is permitted. The drop
  off point is outside the Site Manager's bungalow and not anywhere else
- Speed limit on site is limited to strictly 5mph
- Parents, carers and children should enter through the pedestrian gate and keep to the footpath

Please can you pass this message on to any of your extended family or friends who on occasions bring or collect your children. If you do witness any inconsiderate driving/parking on the roads around the school, please report it via the police non-emergency website.

#### **School Lunches**



Fresh Start provide fantastic school lunches, freshly prepared on site every day. Sourced locally wherever possible, these meals are healthy and balanced and packed full of flavour! Allergies can be catered for but please contact the school office if your child has any which must be considered.

If you would like to order a school lunch for your child, please submit your order directly with Fresh Start on their website by **12:00pm on Thursday** for the following week. Late lunches should only be ordered in an emergency or if there is a sudden change. Thank you for your help with this.

#### **Breakfast and After School Club**

Our wraparound provider is Kid Zone who hold before and after school clubs for all pupils from Reception to Year 6. When signing your child up for this, please indicate your child's new class teacher for this academic year. This helps Kid Zone and the school ensure your child gets safely to the after school club at the end of the day.

### **Accelerated Reader**

Many of you will be familiar with Accelerated Reader which most children from Year 3 upwards are already using, and which many children start to use sometime during Year 2. Star testing and book quizzes still work in the same way, but children will be able to earn online badges and have easy access to their targets in order to track their progress.
