Year 3 MK Museum Trip

Dear Parents & Carers,

To enhance our summer topic on our Local Area Study we have arranged a visit to Milton Keynes Museum on Thursday 13th June 2024.

We plan to leave school at 9.00am and will return to school at approximately 2.30pm. Children should wear full school uniform and bring a lightweight waterproof coat, in case of wet weather. The majority of the day will be inside but the museum consists of multiple buildings and we will be moving between them. During the day, the children will have the opportunity to explore the museum with a focused talk in the Transport Hall to start the day, looking at how transport has changed and evolved over time around Milton Keynes and Winslow.

If you are available to volunteer your time to accompany us on this trip and have a valid DBS certificate please speak to a member of the Year 3 team before the end of this half term.

All children will require a packed lunch for the day. For those parents who order hot meals, Fresh Start Catering do offer a packed lunch alternative. Parents can do this by selecting the meal replacement tab when ordering meals next half term. The packed lunch is a set meal that includes a ham or cheese sandwich, a piece of fruit and a cookie or a piece of cake. **You will still need to provide a drink for your child.**

If you do not have a meal booked on the day of the school trip and have not selected the meal replacement tab, Fresh Start will not provide a packed lunch.

In order to make this trip financially viable, we are requesting a contribution of **£15.00** via ParentMail to be paid by Monday 3rd June. This charge covers coach travel, insurance for your child, and entry into the museum.

If you cannot make the full contribution due to financial constraints or your child is entitled to Pupil Premium, please contact the School Office.
