## Dear Parents and Carers,

We have had another busy week in school with the children working hard to 'Let their light shine' across the curriculum. We are always delighted to recognise the children's academic and personal achievements, both inside and outside the classroom, as well as outside of school. These achievements are always celebrated in our Collective Worship on a Friday.

This week, a group of children from Year Five and Six participated in a Quad Kids Athletics Competition where they represented the school, competing against three other schools in a 600 metre race, vortex throw, standing long jump and a 75 metre sprint.

All the children performed exceptionally well - standing long jump in the rain on a slippery surface was not easy, but their jumps were incredible. The boys and girls sprint races were particularly competitive! Finley in Year Five achieved the fastest time overall with a sub 12 second run. In the Vortex throw, Eddie increased his distance with each throw, achieving a distance of 33.5 metres and even beating the sports leaders! The final event was the 600 metres race. This was not easy, however our children made this look like a walk in the park, with all completing it in under 2 minutes and 45 seconds.

All ten athletes representing our school performed brilliantly. They supported each other with encouragement and advice and enjoyed every second. Mrs Burman and the children were delighted that they earned First Place in the competition; I am sure the parents would agree, this was very well deserved.

Congratulations and well done to: Shaun, Lottie, Lily, Soffee, Abi, Zaiden, Lamara, Henry, Eddie and Finley – we are so proud of you!

Thank you to the parents who transported and supported and for Mrs Burman for arranging the event and accompanying the children.

#### What is Accelerated Reader?

When children have finished the reading schemes, they become 'library readers' and are allowed to borrow two books. At this stage they will start to use 'Accelerated Reader' to help them choose a book. When they have read it they will complete a quiz to check that they have understood it.

Children who use Accelerated Reader (mostly Y2 upwards) can now do their quizzes at home. Please use this link: <u>Accelerated Reader Quiz</u> Children login using their first initial and first four letters of their surname as their username and their library number as their password.

## Tips for using Accelerated Reader at home

In addition to books from school, many books you have at home may have quizzes available, just type the title of the book into the quiz search box. Children can also do vocabulary quizzes, and quizzes on the articles available on the Accelerated Reader website.
