Re: Changes to the School Behaviour Policy

To further reinforce our school's values and ensure consistency in expectations, we have recently updated our Behaviour Policy.

These updates have been made with careful consideration of our aims to support positive relationships, foster self-discipline, and maintain a secure and caring atmosphere for all. They are informed by valuable feedback from our parent survey in the Autumn term and collaboration with staff and children. The updated policy is more inclusive of the needs of all our children and reflects our shared commitment to fairness, respect, and kindness.

Our Behaviour Policy is rooted in our commitment to:

- **Supporting positive relationships:** Every child should feel happy, safe, and secure in an inclusive and respectful environment.
- **Promoting good choices:** Equipping children to make responsible decisions, building strong foundations for their future.
- **Ensuring fairness and consistency:** Applying expectations consistently to foster justice and understanding.
- **Encouraging respect and kindness:** Inspiring children to model respect, honesty, and integrity.

Key updates to the policy include:

1. **Clearer boundaries and expectations:** Reinforced regularly through assemblies, classrooms, and daily interactions.
2. **Enhanced reward systems:** Celebrating positive behaviours to help children understand the impact of their good choices.
3. **Consistent consequences:** Fair and reflective approaches to managing poor behaviour.
4. **Reasonable adjustments for SEND and adverse needs:** Providing tailored support for individual needs to promote inclusion.
5. **Tailored approaches for EYFS learners:** Age-appropriate strategies focusing on social skills, self-regulation, and positive behaviour.
6. **A collaborative approach to bullying and racism:** to continue to ensure all incidents are thoroughly investigated and acted upon immediately.

We value your role in promoting positive behaviour, and your support is vital in reinforcing these messages at home. To help you understand the changes, we will share a summary of the revised policy on our website and host a parent workshop on the **10th March at 2.30pm**. This will be an opportunity to ask questions, share feedback, and learn more about how we can work together to support your child.
