






**Welcome to Year 6's Spring Term Overview.**

This term, we will be learning about:

<p align="center"><b>English</b></p> <p>During the Spring term, we will be using the book <i>Holes</i> by Louis Sachar to generate many opportunities to write. This will include dialogue, Setting and character descriptions, persuasive writing and linking with our Computing topic, the children will be writing a blog, as if they are one of the characters, of their time at Camp Green Lake!</p>	<p align="center"><b>Maths</b></p> <p>Following the White Rose Hub scheme, we will be covering Statistics Fractions, Decimals &amp; Percentages; Area, Perimeter &amp; Volume and Statistics.</p> <p>We will be continuing with Arithmagicians this term to increase speed and fluency in all calculations.</p> 	<p align="center"><b>Science</b></p> <p>We will be studying Electricity. We will learn about simple circuits and how they work, looking at the effects of adding components to these circuits such as switches, buzzers and motors as well as how to draw these items on a diagram. The children will be encouraged to think scientifically in all lessons and participate in discussions.</p> 
<p align="center"><b>History &amp; Geography</b></p> <p>We will be studying the topic "Across Stormy Seas", thinking about the movement of people in and around Britain as well as world-wide. In Geography we will be taking a look at how our world is changing in terms of climate change, extreme weather and sea-level rise.</p> 	<p align="center"><b>Computing</b></p> <p>Our Computing topic for Spring will be "We are Bloggers", where the children will learn all about blogging and then linking with English, create a series of Blogs all about life at Camp Green Lake. The children will then focus on the topic "We are connected", teaching them how to use social media safely and responsibly, tackling online bullying.</p> 	<p align="center"><b>Religious Education</b></p> <p>Our key question for Spring term 1 Do we need a deity to be committed to creating a better world?</p> <p>The key question in Spring 2 is "Is the Resurrection important to Christians?"</p> <p align="center"><b>PSHE</b></p> <p>Our focus for the Spring term is "Rights and Responsibilities" in our own lives as well as in the world around us. In Spring 2 we will focus on "Keeping Myself Safe", which takes a look at knowing who we can trust and staying away from addictive substances.</p>
<p align="center"><b>P.E.</b></p> <p>Our PE will be on Tuesday and Friday this year. TFG will lead PE on Thursday afternoons using our hall or the Muga. Please ensure your child comes into school wearing an appropriate PE kit for the weather. Please bring extra/spare kit in a PE bag if necessary. During Tuesday lessons, we will focus on Football and Basketball. We will build up to mini matches where children will not only play but evaluate other players.</p>	<p align="center"><b>Music</b></p> <p>We will be using Kapow during our music lessons. Our unit for Spring 1 is about film music" where we will be identifying how different styles of music contribute to the feel of the film. In Spring 2, our topic is Pop Art, where children will learn to perform, identify, and create music while exploring rhythms, instruments, and creative expression.</p> <p align="center"><b>French</b></p> <p>This term, the children will learn to describe houses and rooms in French, and write about their home and family with accuracy and creativity.</p> 	<p align="center"><b>Art and DT</b></p> <p>During the Spring term, we will be thinking about the art of Activism and Propaganda, where the children will have the chance to create a poster using collage and stencils about something that they are passionate about. After half term, will see the children explore the idea of Navigating the World in a Digital World. This is a Kapow unit which will enhance their programming skills needing to follow a client brief and present a pitch to the clients at the end.</p>
