




**Welcome to Year 2s Spring Term 2026 Overview.**

This term, we will be learning about:

<p><b>English</b></p> <p>During the Spring term, we will continue to use a text to inspire our writing, detailed below are our text focuses and the writing piece we will be creating.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Jack and the Beanstalk by Miles Kelly where we will be writing a narrative.</li> <li>- Jim and the Beanstalk by Raymond Briggs where we will be writing a character description, a letter and designing an invention.</li> <li>- We will be writing instructions on how to make a wrap based on our DT unit in Spring 1. Within this, we will learn how to use adverbs.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Maths</b></p> <p>Following the White Rose Hub scheme, we will be covering money, multiplication and division and fractions.</p> 	<p><b>Science</b></p> <p>We will be studying <b>living things and habitats</b> where we will learn what a habitat is, how they provide for the basic needs of plants and animals. We will explore habitats around the world as well as making regular observations of our habitats within school, such as the woodland.</p> 
<p><b>History &amp; Geography</b></p> <p>Our history learning will centre around the <b>emergency services</b> where we will look at how these have changed over time. We will also learn about the key historical figures: Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole.</p> <p>In Geography, we will be following on from our learning about the oceans and continents to focus in on <b>Antarctica</b>. We will identify key human and physical features, contrast to the UK and explore the importance of the 2041 Antarctic Treaty.</p>	<p><b>Computing</b></p> <p>Our Computing units are:</p> <p><b>'We are photographers'</b> focusing on taking better photos.</p> <p><b>'We are safe researchers'</b> focusing on researching a topic.</p> 	<p><b>Religious Education</b></p> <p>Our key question for Spring term 1 is- <b>How do Christians know what is right?</b></p> <p>The key question in Spring 2 is- <b>What does the Torah mean for Jewish people?</b></p> <p><b>PSHE</b></p> <p>Our focus for the Spring term is "Keeping Myself Safe", which takes a look at what feeling safe is like, what things make us feel safe and what things do not. In Spring 2 we will focus on "Rights and Respect" in our own lives as well as in the world around us.</p>
<p><b>P.E.</b></p> <p>Our PE will be on Monday and Wednesday. TFG will lead PE on Wednesday afternoons using our hall or the Muga. Please ensure your child comes into school wearing an appropriate PE kit for the weather. Please bring extra/spare kit in a PE bag if necessary.</p>	<p><b>Music</b></p> <p>Our first unit's theme is 'On the island'. In this new unit, the children learn folk songs and create sounds to represent three contrasting landscapes: seaside, countryside and city.</p> <p>In our second unit, the them is 'Space'. This new unit helps children with developing knowledge and understanding of dynamics using instruments; learning to compose and play rhythms to represent planets.</p>	<p><b>Art and DT</b></p> <p>We will be making a healthy, balanced wrap in DT with a focus on learning how to chop, grate, mash and peel different vegetables. We will design a balanced wrap using a design criteria and evaluate it against this.</p> <p>During the second half of the term in art, we will explore monoprinting.</p>
