





**Welcome to Year 3's Summer Term Overview.**

**This term, we will be learning about:**

<p><b>English</b></p> <p>This term, we are reading, 'Leo and the Gorgon's Curse.' This is helping us to write our own guide to defeating Greek beasts.</p> <p>We are also reading, 'The Boy Who Grew Dragons' in Book Talk and linking some of our English to this. The children will be writing diary entries in role as the main character.</p> 	<p><b>Maths</b></p> <p>We will be continuing to learn about fractions this term before moving on to looking at money and telling the time. Throughout the term we will revisit previous learning in the four operations.</p> 	<p><b>Science</b></p>  <p>Our Science this term will explore the topic of plants including discussing functions of different parts of the plant and their life cycles. We will also discuss how seeds are dispersed and why this is important.</p> <p>Following this we will begin to explore magnets and how they use forces to attract and repel. We will focus on classifying materials using magnets and create investigations around these.</p>
<p><b>History/Geography</b></p> <p>Our topic this term brings us to the local area with a study of the history of schools in Winslow itself. We will use a variety of sources to find out the differences and similarities between schools across time. In Geography, we will continue to use maps to help us explore our local area through map reading skills.</p> 	<p><b>Computing</b></p> <p>This term Year 3 are planning and creating a Wikipedia style page. This involves researching using the search engine, Kiddle and then using hyperlinks in PowerPoint to present their pages.</p> 	<p><b>Religious Education and PSHE</b></p> <p>In RE, we will be asking the question What is the Qur'an and why do Muslims try to learn it by heart? We will be looking at Sacred texts and comparing Muslim beliefs with Christian and Jewish beliefs.</p> <p>Meanwhile in PSHE, we will be exploring how to keep active and healthy lives and our relationships with others and how these change over time. We will also be discussing how our bodies change and grow throughout our lives.</p>
<p><b>P.E.</b></p> <p>We aim to develop practical skills in order to participate, compete and lead a healthy lifestyle through athletics as well as developing netball skills. We will also learn skills relating to cricket and football.</p> <p><b>French</b></p> <p>We will be building our French knowledge by learning about different types of transport and the names of different animals in French.</p>	<p><b>Music</b></p> <p>Our music work this term will look at songs which look at the history of Jazz and Ragtime music. The second half of the term we will be looking at music from India.</p> 	<p><b>Art &amp; DT</b></p> <p>Our Art this term involves telling stories through drawing and making. In DT we will be designing and making magnificent bags, helping us to develop our sewing skills.</p>
