Dear Parents & Carers,

In September, when your child enters Year 3, they will begin studying the Stone Age to Iron Age as part of the Key Stage 2 History curriculum. To support this learning, we have arranged a trip to **The Chiltern Open Air Museum** on **Tuesday 29th September**. This visit will help bring the topic to life and deepen the children's understanding of prehistoric Britain.

During the trip, children will build stone age shelters and create a stone age drawing. They will learn about past lifestyles, and take part in hands-on activities. Under the guidance of museum staff, they will re-enact a Stone Age hunt, learn how to make fire, create an Iron Age pot, and make flatbreads and butter.

The children will require a packed lunch for the day. Fresh Start Catering do offer a packed lunch option on school trip days and parents can do this by selecting the meal replacement tab when ordering meals next half term. **They do not provide a drink so please be aware you will need to supply this.**

Further details will be shared closer to the date. To make the trip financially viable, we are asking for a **£24.00 contribution via ParentMail by Monday 31st August**. This cost covers coach travel, museum entry, workshops, and insurance. Although contributions are voluntary and no child will be excluded, the trip has been budgeted on the assumption that all families contribute. If insufficient contributions are received, we may need to reconsider or cancel the trip. If you receive free school meals or have financial concerns, please speak confidentially to the School Business Manager.

More information will be given at the transition meeting but we hope the children are looking forward to this exciting experience as much as we are!
